

## TRÊS BAGOS SAUVIGNON BLANC

### WHITE 2025 | REGIONAL DURIENSE

Três Bagos Sauvignon Blanc is the result of an experiment carried out during the 2000 harvest, which proved a huge commercial success in Portugal, where it has become the benchmark for wines of this variety originating from the Loire Valley in France.

It is a 100% single-varietal wine that expresses the fresh aromas associated with the variety, but in which the schist soils and altitude (vines planted at over 420 metres) reveal a mineral and restrained profile. For this style, deciding on the right moment for the harvest is absolutely crucial. Its acidity, combined with partial ageing in wood, gives it structure and great ageing potential. Over time, it develops a more complex and vegetal profile (asparagus).

**Grapes:** Sauvignon Blanc  
**Soil:** Schist  
**Vineyards:** 25 to 30 years

**Harvest:** Manual in small cases  
**Vinificação:** 80% Inox and 20% in oak barrels  
**Ageing:** 80% Inox and 20% in new French oak barrel for 4 to 5 months

### Tasting Notes

**Color:** Vibrant, Lemon Yellow

**Nose:** Exuberant and fresh, it is highly aromatic. It features notes of tropical fruit, contrasting with fresher fruits such as pineapple and melon, complemented by subtle vegetal notes reminiscent of asparagus.

**Mouth:** The entry is fresh, flavourful and very fruity. It displays good acidity, backed by fresh pineapple-like fruit flavours, with some tropical notes that characterise it and lend it complexity. Very well-balanced, it has a long, lingering finish. Excellent ageing potential.

**Serving Temperature:** 11.°C

**Harmonization:** Perfect as an appetizer or part of a meal, it pairs well with salads, fish, seafood, and Korean or Japanese dishes, especially sushi. It's also suitable for both vegans and vegetarians.
